And yet, we also have our challenges. We owe the same amount on our buildings as we did in 2012, and our payments to the Diocese increase every year.

This is where the Next Dream Campaign comes in. We have a chance to put much of our debt behind us, which then offers us the opportunity to expand our staff and increase our programming. We have a chance to dream once more, and to see God do something amazing.



Our Financial Picture

Loan Details

- Lender: The Episcopal Diocese of Kansas
- Current Principal: \$1,213,207
- Approximately 60% of what we owe the Diocese is for the construction of our Parish Center, and 40% for the construction of our Sanctuary.

Loan Terms

- We are paying interest only until 2028.
- Payments increase annually by 6.43%.
- The 2023 annual repayment is \$35,234.
- In 2028, this repayment will be \$48,260.
- In 2033, this repayment will be \$66,102.

Our Opportunity

Diocese of Kansas Grant

- The Episcopal Diocese of Kansas has awarded St. Margaret's a matching grant for the Next Dream Campaign.
- This matching grant will award one dollar of loan forgiveness for every dollar that St. Margaret's raises.
- <u>Every gift you give will have double the</u> <u>impact</u>. As a result, we anticipate eliminating a majority of our debt to the Diocese because of the Campaign.

Going Forward

- The Diocese has agreed to reamortize our loan every year until we complete the Next Dream Campaign.
- This means that the Campaign could have an immediate impact on our finances, lowering our repayments.
